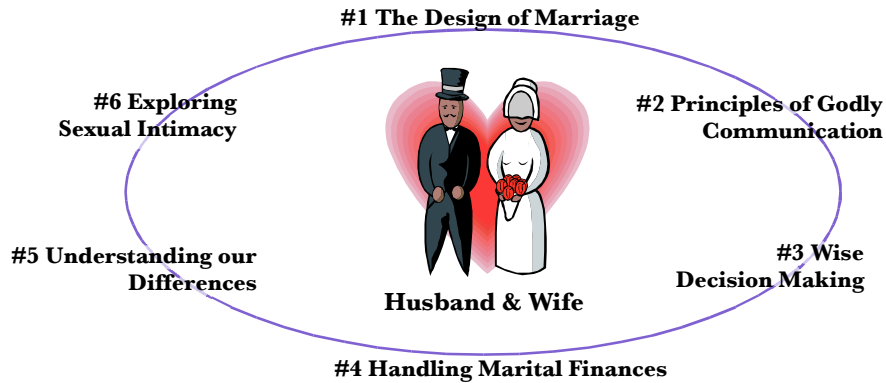

(Psalms 127:1)

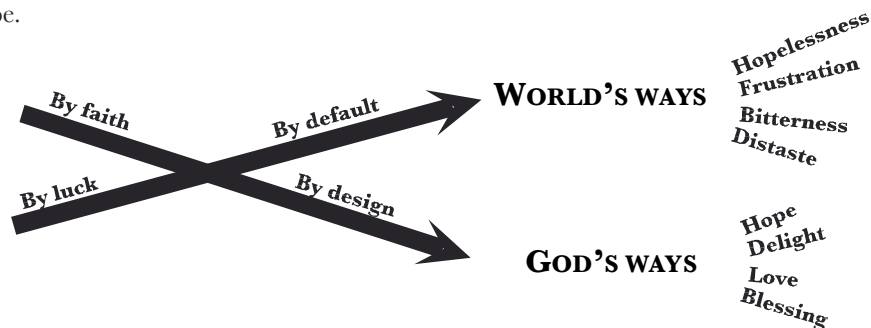


🌸 The Glory of Marriage
